To request a **presentation slot** please submit a paper or abstract to <u>daeina@daeina.net</u> **before April 1, 2014**. We encourage the presentation of preliminary work, particularly from PhD students. In allocating slots, particular preference will also be given to PhD students who are about to go on the academic job market.

In addition to requests for presentation slots, we also ask all interested DAEiNA members to submit a non-binding **expression of interest** to <u>daeina@daeina.net</u> as soon as possible in order to facilitate coordination of rooms as well as catering.

DAEiNA is still in the process of applying for funds to cover travel and hotel costs for a small number of people; however, participants are strongly encouraged to **seek funds on their own**. For students in particular, signing up to present at the meetings may be a good way of securing travel funding from their home institution.
